Social Security Safety Dividend Act of 2016

This bill directs the Department of the Treasury to disburse a \$250 cash payment for a particular year to recipients of Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income benefits (under title XVI of the Social Security Act), railroad retirement benefits, or veterans disability compensation or pension benefits if no cost-of-living adjustment is payable for any month in such a year.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 19, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Oct 6, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Sep 28, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 28, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
