Summary (as of Nov 14, 2016)

Military Hunger Prevention Act

This bill excludes the value of a housing allowance for a member of a uniformed service from any income, assets, or resources calculation for determining eligibility for the supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP, formerly known as the food stamp program) and the family subsistence supplemental allowance program.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 9, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition.
- **Dec 1, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Nov 14, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 14, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
