Summary (as of Dec 7, 2016)

End the Backlog Act

This bill requires that if the total amount appropriated for the Executive Office for Immigration Review does not exceed \$485.3 million for FY2017, the total amount authorized to be appropriated for FY2018 and each of the three succeeding fiscal years for: (1) U.S. Customs and Border Protection is \$13,219,051; and (2) U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement is \$6,151,579.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 12, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security.
- **Dec 7, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Dec 7, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
