Summary (as of Dec 8, 2016)

This bill amends the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to require the Department of Health and Human Services to deposit monthly in the Treasury \$1.50 for each individual enrolled in health insurance coverage through a federally operated health insurance exchange.

The user fee charged to health insurers by federally operated health insurance exchanges may not exceed a specified percentage of a plan's premiums.
