Summary (as of Apr 19, 2016)

Commends the National Alliance of Specialized Instructional Support Personnel for its efforts to promote and improve the availability of specialized instructional support services.

Urges government agencies and policymakers to work together to incorporate such personnel and services in education reform efforts. Encourages experts to share best practices.

Urges the Department of Education to provide states and local educational agencies with guidance on effectively using such personnel to improve schools.
