Encourages Armed Forces commanders to support appropriate treatment of personnel diagnosed with PTSI.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 1, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Nov 17, 2016:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 17, 2016:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Nov 17, 2016:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
