## **Military Track Register and Alert Communities Act of 2015 or the Military TRAC Act**

Amends the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006 to require the Department of Defense to maintain a sex offender registry of individuals convicted of certain sex offenses under the Uniform Code of Military Justice or of other military offenses appropriate for sex offender registration purposes.

### **Actions Timeline**

---

- **Nov 23, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Mar 16, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Feb 12, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 12, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
