Summary (as of Nov 19, 2015)

Expresses the sense of Congress regarding:

- elimination of homelessness by 2020;
- expanded funding for the Section 8 rental housing voucher program;
- substantial additional funding to the National Housing Trust Fund;
- increased funding for job training and related programs;
- a federal "housing first" policy linking housing with supportive services for persons with special needs; and
- permanent housing connected to employment, transportation, and job training programs for American families and individuals.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 19, 2015:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 19, 2015:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Nov 19, 2015:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
