Sets forth the rule for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 119) expressing the sense of Congress that a carbon tax would be detrimental to the United States economy.

Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question on H.Res. 1001 until later in the legislative day.
