Summary (as of Feb 27, 2017)

Domestic Research Enhancement Act of 2017

This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow a research tax credit for 35% of in-house research expenses (contracted research expenses), including any research funded by any grant or contract or by another person or governmental entity.
