Summary (as of Apr 4, 2017)

Encouraging Employee Ownership Act of 2017

(Sec. 2) This bill requires the Securities and Exchange Commission to increase, from \$5 million to \$10 million, the 12-month sales threshold beyond which an issuer is required to provide investors with additional disclosures related to compensatory benefit plans.

- **Apr 4, 2017:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 1343 with 1 hour of general debate. Motion to recommit with or without instructions allowed.
- **Apr 4, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 1343.
- **Apr 4, 2017:** DEBATE - Pursuant to the provisions of H.Res. 240, the House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Polis amendment.
- **Apr 4, 2017:** Mr. Swalwell (CA) moved to recommit with instructions to the Committee on Financial Services. (text: CR H2675)
- **Apr 4, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the motion to recommit with instructions. The instructions contained in the motion seek to require the bill to be reported back to the House with an amendment to add a section to prohibit any exemption to an issuer if the issuer or affiliate of the issuer has withheld information from Congress relevant to its investigation of any collusion between persons associated with the Russian Government and persons associated with a presidential campaign.
- **Apr 4, 2017:** The previous question on the motion to recommit with instructions was ordered without objection.
