Summary (as of Jul 24, 2018)

Native American Health Savings Improvement Act

(Sec. 2) This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to specify that receiving hospital care or medical services under a medical care program of the Indian Health Service or a tribal organization does not disqualify an individual from being eligible for a health savings account.

Actions Timeline
