### Summary (as of Jan 17, 2017)

#### Rewarding Achievement and Incentivizing Successful Employees Act or the RAISE Act

This bill amends the National Labor Relations Act to allow an employer to pay an employee higher wages, pay, or other compensation than provided for in a collective bargaining agreement.
