### Summary (as of Mar 28, 2017)

#### Medical Practice Freedom Act of 2017

This bill prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services or any state from requiring a health care provider, as a condition of the provider's licensure, to participate in a health plan or comply with requirements for meaningful use of electronic health records.
