Veterans Education Priority Enrollment Act of 2017

This bill prohibits the Department of Veterans Affairs or a state approving agency from approving a program of education offered by an educational institution for purposes of an educational assistance program for veterans or members of the Selected Reserve or the Ready Reserve of the Armed Forces unless any such institution that administers a priority enrollment system allows an eligible veteran, member, or dependent to enroll in courses at the earliest possible time.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 12, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Mar 29, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 29, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Mar 29, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
