### Summary (as of Apr 5, 2017)

#### Returning Worker Accountability Act of 2017

This bill exempts from the nonimmigrant H-2B visa (temporary nonagricultural services) annual numerical limitation for a fiscal year a returning worker who has already been counted toward such limitation during any of the preceding three fiscal years.
