What Works to Move Welfare Recipients into Jobs Act

This bill modifies requirements for the Department of Health and Human Services to research practices and projects that have moved recipients under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program into jobs.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 28, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **Apr 25, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 25, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
