## Summary (as of May 4, 2017)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary has been expanded because action occurred on the measure.)

(Sec. 1) This bill amends the Public Health Service Act, if the American Health Care Act (H.R. 1628) is enacted, to make plans made available by the federal government to Members of Congress and congressional staff subject to state waivers of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) requirement for health insurance to cover the essential health benefits and PPACA restrictions on premium variation by age and health status.

- **Jun 7, 2017:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
- **May 4, 2017:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 308. (consideration: CR H4139-4149)
- **May 4, 2017:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2192 and H.R. 1628. Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2192 under a closed rule, with one hour of general debate and one motion to recommit. Rule also provides for further consideration of H.R. 1628 and provides that further amendments printed in House Report 115-109 be considered as adopted.
- **May 4, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 2192.
- **May 4, 2017:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- **May 4, 2017:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.R. 2192, the Chair put the question on passage of the bill and by voice vote announced that the yeas had prevailed.
