## Summary (as of Apr 27, 2017)

This bill requires the Department of Energy to establish a pilot program to award grants for providing nonprofit buildings with energy-efficiency materials.

The bill reduces the authorization of appropriations for the zero net energy commercial buildings initiative for FY2018.
