Rio Puerco Watershed Management Program Reauthorization Act

This bill amends the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to reauthorize the Rio Puerco Management Committee and the Rio Puerco Watershed Management Program for 10 years from this bill's enactment. Both the committee and the program address the protection and restoration of the Rio Puerco Watershed in New Mexico.

- **Feb 7, 2018:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee on Public Lands, Forests, and Mining. Hearings held. With printed Hearing: S.Hrg. 115-502.
- **Dec 19, 2017:** Introduced in Senate
- **Dec 19, 2017:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
