Standard Data and Technology Advancement Act of 2017 or the Standard DATA Act of 2017

This bill amends title XI (General Provisions) of the Social Security Act (SSAct) to direct human services programs operating under the SSAct to designate nonproprietary, interoperable data-exchange standards for information exchanged electronically between state agencies.

Actions Timeline

- **May 10, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Human Resources.
- **May 5, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Apr 28, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 28, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
