Summary (as of Jan 11, 2018)

Federal Adjustment of Income Rates Act of 2018 or the FAIR Act

This bill increases by 3% in FY2019 the rates of basic pay for federal employees under the statutory pay systems (i.e., the General Schedule, the Foreign Service Schedule, and various schedules related to the Veterans Health Administration) and for prevailing rate employees.
