Summary (as of May 17, 2017)

Accelerating Innovation in Medicine Act of 2017 or the AIM Act of 2017

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to develop, maintain, and make publicly available a list of medical devices that shall be voluntarily excluded from payment under the Medicare program. A Medicare beneficiary who consents to receive such a medical device shall be responsible for payment for the device.

A manufacturer seeking to have a medical device included in the list must submit a request for inclusion to the CMS, in accordance with specified timelines. As a condition for a device's continued inclusion on the list, a manufacturer must provide the CMS with data on clinical studies completed with respect to the device.

- **May 30, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 19, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 17, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **May 17, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
