### Summary (as of Apr 11, 2018)

#### Fairness to Pet Owners Act of 2018

This bill directs the Federal Trade Commission to require a prescriber of a household-animal medication to provide a free copy of the prescription to the pet owner before offering to fill the prescription and without the pet owner having to request a copy.
