## **Commission on Americans Living Abroad Act of 2017**

This bill establishes the Commission on Americans Living Abroad which shall conduct a study of how federal laws and policies affect U.S. citizens living abroad, including civilians and members of the Armed Forces.

Each federal agency affected by a recommendation in the report required by this bill shall submit a response to the President, Congress, and the Commission.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **May 26, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 25, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2017:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E725)
- **May 25, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committees on Financial Services, Ways and Means, the Judiciary, House Administration, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
