### Summary (as of Apr 19, 2018)

This bill amends the Federal Crop Insurance Act to limit federal crop insurance premium subsidies provided to agricultural producers to \$40,000. The limit applies to the total amount of premiums paid by the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation on behalf of a person or legal entity for all policies issued for a crop year.
