### Summary (as of May 25, 2017)

#### End Subsidies for Tobacco Act

This bill amends the Federal Crop Insurance Act to prohibit the Department of Agriculture from subsidizing crop insurance premiums for tobacco. Any savings that occur as a result of this bill must be deposited in the Treasury and used for deficit reduction.

### Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on General Farm Commodities and Risk Management.
- **May 25, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2017:** Referred to the House Committee on Agriculture.
