### Summary (as of May 25, 2017)

#### Ensuring Quality Education for Veterans Act

This bill amends title IV (Student Assistance) of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to make proprietary institutions of higher education ineligible to receive educational assistance from Department of Defense or Veterans Affairs programs.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Jul 17, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **May 25, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services, and Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **May 25, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
