Military Residency Choice Act

(Sec. 2) This bill amends the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act to permit the spouse of a service member to elect to use the same residence as the service member for purposes of taxation and voting, regardless of the date on which the marriage of the spouse and the service member occurred.

- **Jul 24, 2017:** Reported by the Committee on Veterans' Affairs. H. Rept. 115-245.
- **Jul 24, 2017:** Placed on the Union Calendar, Calendar No. 177.
- **Jul 24, 2017:** Mr. Roe (TN) moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Jul 24, 2017:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H6170-6171)
- **Jul 24, 2017:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 282.
- **Jul 24, 2017:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Walz objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was considered as withdrawn.
