### Summary (as of May 15, 2018)

#### **Military Family Prevention, Response, and Other Training to End Military Family Abuse and Connect Communities Today Act or Military Family PROTECT Act**

This bill requires the establishment on military installations multidisciplinary teams on child abuse and other domestic violence.

The Defense Health Agency of the Department of Defense must carry out a pilot program on universal nurse home visits for providing families training on safe childcare practices aimed at reducing child abuse and fatalities.
