Summary (as of Jun 13, 2017)

Fair COLA for Seniors Act of 2017

This bill amends title II (Old Age, Survivors, and Disability Insurance) (OASDI) of the Social Security Act to, with respect to OASDI benefits: (1) apply a 3.9% cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for the second half of 2017, and (2) revise the computation of COLAs to use the Consumer Price Index for Elderly Consumers.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 22, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Social Security.
- **Jun 13, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 13, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
