Summary (as of May 22, 2018)

Comprehensive Screenings for Seniors Act of 2018

This bill requires the initial examinations for new enrollees and annual wellness visits under Medicare to include: (1) a screening for potential substance use disorders, and (2) a review of any current opioid prescriptions.
