## **Gulf States Coordination Act**

This bill designates the Gulf of Mexico Alliance as a regional coordination partnership that will strengthen collaboration efforts among federal, state, local, and private participants in the five Gulf states (Alabama, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Texas) to restore and protect the Gulf of Mexico ecosystem.

The alliance may provide grants to carry out this bill, including to research the effects of natural and human-induced environmental changes on the water quality and living resources of the Gulf of Mexico ecosystem.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **May 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment.
- **Jun 16, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Jun 15, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committees on Natural Resources, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
