Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 244) to encourage effective, voluntary investments to recruit, employ, and retain men and women who have served in the United States military with annual Federal awards to employers recognizing such efforts.

- **May 2, 2017:** Rule provides for one hour of general debate. The resolution makes in order a single motion that the House concur in the Senate amendments numbered 2 and 3, and that the House concur in the Senate amendment numbered 1 with an amendment consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 115-16 modified by the amendment printed in House Report 115-108.
- **May 2, 2017:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 45.
