Summary (as of Jun 29, 2017)

Protecting Honest Fishermen Act of 2017

This bill expands requirements related to the safety, traceability, and labeling of commercially marketed seafood, including by requiring the labeling for such seafood to indicate whether the seafood was previously frozen and whether it was harvested in a different country from the one in which it was processed.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 9, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.
- **Jul 24, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Livestock and Foreign Agriculture.
- **Jul 17, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
- **Jun 30, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 29, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 29, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
