### Summary (as of Jun 21, 2018)

#### Combat Valley Fever Act

This bill requires the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to establish a registry and award grants for the purpose of tracking cases of coccidioidomycosis (also known as Valley fever)—a lung infection caused by a certain fungus found in soil.
