### Summary (as of Jul 6, 2017)

This bill amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to allow renal dialysis facilities to be accredited by an approved accreditation body for participation in the Medicare program. The bill also establishes a time frame with respect to initial surveys of renal dialysis facilities.

## Actions Timeline

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- **Jul 20, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 6, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 6, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
