#### Protect Utah's Rural Economy Act

This bill prohibits the President from establishing or extending national monuments in Utah unless:

- the proposed establishment or extension has been authorized by an Act of Congress, and
- the President has received a notice from the Governor of Utah that the state legislature has enacted legislation approving of the proposed establishment or extension.

### Actions Timeline

- **Jul 11, 2018:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jul 11, 2018:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
