### Summary (as of Aug 28, 2018)

#### Guarantee Access to Arts and Music Education Act of 2018 or the GAAME Act of 2018

This bill amends the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to specify that Title I funds (which support the instructional needs of students from low-income families) may be used for arts and music programs.
