Urges the President to take care that the laws are faithfully executed by: (1) ensuring cost sharing reduction payments under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) are paid; (2) enforcing PPACA's individual mandate provisions; (3) working with states and insurers to make sure that consumers have options; and (4) providing adequate funding for specified PPACA activities.

Discourages the President from using executive actions to undermine PPACA.

- **May 26, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 22, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 19, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **May 19, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
