Summary (as of Jul 27, 2017)

Evidence-Based Telehealth Expansion Act of 2017

This bill authorizes the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to waive certain requirements relating to coverage of telehealth services under Medicare (e.g., originating site requirements) if certain conditions are met.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 28, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 27, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 27, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
