### Summary (as of Oct 11, 2018)

#### No More Surprise Medical Bills Act of 2018

This bill establishes several requirements relating to billing practices for out-of-network services provided by certain health care providers (e.g., hospitals), including notice and consent requirements; specified providers must also comply with such requirements as a condition of Medicare participation.
