Summary (as of Sep 5, 2017)

Protecting Against Tyranny and Responsible Imports Act (PATRIA) of 2017

This bill prohibits the import of specified petroleum products from Venezuela until the President certifies to Congress that Venezuela has dissolved that country's Constituent Assembly and restored the National Assembly.
