Summary (as of Nov 29, 2018)

This bill expands the E-3 visa program to cover Irish nationals, which is currently only available to Australian nationals. For Irish E-3 initial applications, the Department of State may approve each fiscal year no more than 10,500 minus the number of Australian initial applications approved the previous fiscal year.
