- legislation to ban assault weapons and large capacity ammunition magazines.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 23, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Jun 9, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 2, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 2, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
