Energy Technology Maturation Act of 2017

This bill requires the Department of Energy (DOE) to establish a funding program to facilitate the commercialization of energy and related technologies that exhibit promising commercial potential and are developed at DOE facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2018:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Oct 17, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Strategic Forces.
- **Sep 12, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 12, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
