Summary (as of Dec 19, 2018)

Community College Student Success Act

This bill requires the Department of Education to carry out a community college student success grant program that awards grants to public, two-year institutions of higher education (IHEs) for planning and implementing programs designed to increase the rate at which their students graduate or transfer to a four-year IHE.
