Summary (as of Sep 14, 2017)

Sewage Free Tijuana River Valley Act of 2017

This bill directs the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to carry out a program to enhance the physical infrastructure in both the United States and Mexico to prevent flooding and wastewater, sewage, trash, and sediment spills in the Tijuana River Valley, including carrying out coordinated restoration and protection activities that enhance the infrastructure. In establishing the program, the Corps of Engineers must consult with specified heads of federal agencies, commissions, state and local governments, and Mexican governments.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 29, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Western Hemisphere.
- **Sep 15, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- **Sep 15, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **Sep 14, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 14, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
