Summary (as of Jan 9, 2017)

IRGC Terrorist Designation Act

This bill expresses the sense of Congress that Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) meets the criteria for designation as a foreign terrorist organization and should be so designated by the Department of State.

State shall submit to Congress: (1) a detailed report on whether the IRGC meets such criteria; and (2) if State determines the IRGC does not meet such criteria, a detailed justification as to which criteria have not been met.

- **Feb 6, 2017:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security, and Investigations.
- **Jan 9, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 9, 2017:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
