### Summary (as of Jan 10, 2017)

#### Ensuring the Safety of Our Military Aviators Act of 2017

This bill prohibits the Department of Defense from approving any application for the construction or alteration of a wind turbine that is proposed to be constructed or altered within 25 miles of a military airbase or military airfield.

- **Jan 10, 2017:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 10, 2017:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
